### **Notes From The Nurses Office**

It's officially cold and flu season! Here are a few tips from the CIS Nurse's office to help combat respiratory season!

- 1. Discuss getting your child vaccinated for the Flu with your primary care provider.
- 2. If you have a fever or flu symptoms stay home & follow up with your primary care provider.
- 3. Keep your child home until fever free for 24 hours without use of medication such as Tylenol/Ibuprofen.
- 4. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue, not your hands, when coughing or sneezing.
- 5. Wash your hands frequently with soap and water.
- 6. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- 7. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home & school.
- 8. Practice healthy habits: Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids and eat nutritious food.
