



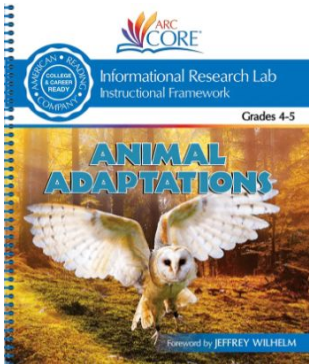

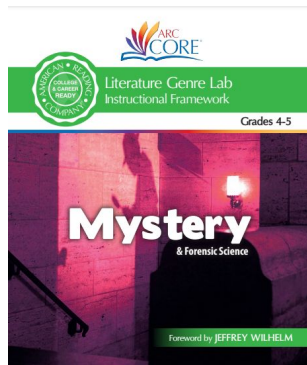


## English Language Arts

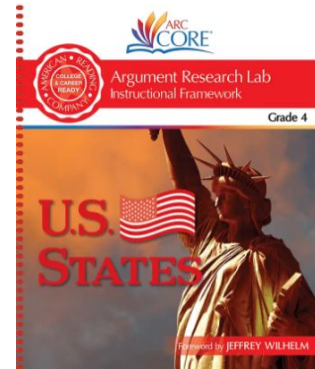

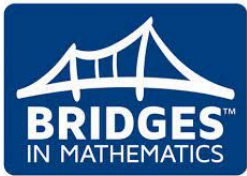
